2023 MABEL MACKENZIE BROOCH EVENT

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. There is NO Entry Fee for this event.
2. Please make sure that players are all currently financial members of the VWGA.
3. The Mabel Mackenzie Brooch event should be played as an 18 HOLE **STROKE** EVENT and the course must be set up in a Championship style with all tee blocks off the plates during the months of **FEBRUARY, MARCH, APRIL** or **MAY**.

Results should be emailed to **Lucy Minehan** who is the Mabel Mackenzie Brooch Co-Coordinator, no later than Friday 16 June 2023. Lucy's email address is: **office.vwga@bigpond.com**.

4. If harsh weather prevents play between February, March, April and May, approval to reschedule this event must be required by contacting Lucy on 0408 359 502.
However, winners will only be eligible for item 11. but **NOT** item 12.
5. The Mabel Mackenzie Brooch event may only be entered **ONCE** by each player at her HOME CLUB, i.e. the club where the player's VWGA annual subscriptions are paid.
6. A player may only win **ONE** trophy.
7. Handicap limit for this event is to 45.4. If a player has a handicap more than 45, then she should play off a 45 handicap on the day of this event.
8. Winners are those players with the best Nett Score over the entire week, regardless of whether the event was played midweek or weekend. There is no separate division for weekend players.
9. DO NOT SEND CARDS as we are able to confirm scores via GolfLink, **but please retain the cards until the end of June, as we may require them for countback purposes**.
Ties are to be decided by GolfNSW's count back method.
10. Senior Veteran must be 70 years or over on the day of the competition.
11. All winners at Club level will receive a VWGA Hat Clip.
12. Overall winners at the end of the competition, in each division, will receive a Gift Voucher.
13. Divisions are determined on a players GA handicap and linked to GolfNSW's Divisions.

Division 1: 0 to 20.0

Division 2: 20.1 to 29.0

Division 3: 29.1 to 45.4

Senior Veteran: 0 to 45.4

The results must be determined on the Scratch Rating (SR) of the course on the day of play.

NOT the Par Rating of the course. **Where to find the SR and PCC**; on completion of the event, go to **www.golf.org.au** to get the SR and PCC using the GolfLink number of each winning player. Sometimes the PCC is referred to as the "daily difficulty".
