2025 COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIP

The Country Championship event was introduced in 1976, which makes this event 49 years old.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. There is NO Entry Fee for this event.
2. Please make sure that all players are all currently financial members of the VWGA.
3. The Country Championship event should be played as an 18 HOLE **STROKE** EVENT. The course must be set up in a championship style and **all tee blocks must be on the plates** as if this was a Club Board event or a Monthly Medal event.
4. The Country Championship should be played at a time convenient to the Club during the months of **FEBRUARY, MARCH, APRIL** or **MAY**. All results should be emailed to Susie Davies, CC Co-Ordinator **no later than** 31 May to: office.vwga@bigpond.com
5. **It is strongly advised that** you try and program this event in the earlier part of the allocated 4 months, as inclement weather may prevent you playing this event in the latter part of the 4 months. Should this event be played outside the allotted 4 months, club winners will be eligible for item 11, but **NOT** item 13.
6. The Country Championship event may only be entered **ONCE** by each player at her HOME CLUB, i.e. the club where the player's VWGA annual subscriptions are paid.
7. Handicap limit for this event is to 45.4. If a player has a handicap more than 45, then she should play off a 45 handicap on the day of this event.
8. If possible, the competition for weekday and weekend, should be scheduled within the same week.
9. **DO NOT SEND CARDS** as we are able to confirm scores via GolfLink, **but please retain the cards until the end of June, as we may require them for countback purposes**. Ties are to be decided by GolfNSW's count back method.
10. Senior Veteran must be 70 years or over on the day of the competition.
11. **PLEASE NOTE: The Country Championship event is divided into two sections, GROSS and NETT. A player CAN'T win both sections, she can only win ONE trophy. Gross takes priority over Nett.**
12. All winners at Club level will receive a VWGA Hat Clip.
13. Overall winners in each division, Gross and Nett, will receive a Gift Voucher.
14. Divisions are determined on a players GA handicap and linked to GolfNSW's Divisions.

Division 1: 0 to 20.0 | Division 2: 20.1 to 29.0 | Division 3: 29.1 to 45.4
Weekend: 0 to 45.4 | Senior Veteran: 0 to 45.4

The results must be determined on the Scratch Rating (SR) of the course on the day of play. **NOT** on the Par Rating of the course. **Where to find the SR and PCC**; on completion of the event, go to www.golf.org.au to get the SR and PCC using the GolfLink number of each winning player. **Sometimes the PCC is referred to as the "daily difficulty" (DD).**
